

## Latest Guidance 16<sup>th</sup> October 2020

Following the latest Government and LTA advice, Haslemere is in Tier 1 and we can continue to play social tennis with people outside of our household and hold organised events such as club sessions. However, Track and Trace regulations and Social Distancing must be followed.

### The following restrictions remain in place.

- Players must maintain a 2 metre distance at all times. If you can touch someone with your racket, you are not 2 metres apart.
- A limit of 22 players at any club sessions, which must be booked.
- Change ends using opposite sides of the court.
- There should be no physical contact between players and no handshaking.
- A maximum court booking slot of 90 mins is allowed but please allow players to come off court before entering.
- All players should follow Public Health England hygiene guidance. Hand sanitizer is available at the club.
- To help reduce any bottlenecks on Saturday mornings:-
  - Sit out on grass bank by court 1 if the area outside clubhouse is busy
  - Use the back gate between courts 3 & 4 to access these courts
- The club has temporarily suspended the restriction on non-members playing more than 3 times per year **BUT** the member must register the non-members details on the booking system and pay a £5 court fee in advance.

### The club must keep records of ALL those playing on our courts. Therefore:-

- All courts must be booked in advance and your opponents name registered on the booking form. See [here](#) for details.
